

SQE: The New(ish) Route to Legal Qualification

What is the SQE?

The Solicitors Qualifying Exam (SQE) is a national licensing exam developed by the Solicitors Regulation Authority (SRA). It was introduced in September 2021, replacing the Legal Practice Course (LPC) as the only way to qualify as a solicitor in England and Wales.

The SQE pathway starts with a degree or Level 6 equivalent qualification. Candidates will need to pass the SQE1 and SQE2 exams, do two years of qualifying work experience (QWE) before, during or after the exams, and pass the character and suitability checks by the SRA, which include checking for a criminal record and bad credit.

Is the SQE compulsory?

We're in a <u>transitional period</u>: From this year, all new graduates have to follow the SQE route to qualification. (But those who are already on the LPC pathway have a few more years' grace to complete their pathway.)

I'm a law graduate:

Yes!

Whether you want to become a solicitor or use your knowledge on a different career path, the SQE will stand you apart as someone of high intellect, tenacity, ambition and integrity.

You can go straight into the Solicitors
Qualifying Exams after uni without having to secure a training contract.

I'm a non-law graduate:

Yes!

You no longer need to do a conversion course such as the GDL. At BARBRI we do offer a Foundations in Law course to introduce you to common legal terms and the legal system in England and Wales, and we also offer a 40-week SQE1 preparation course to give you the maximum amount of time to absorb all you need to know to pass the SQE1 exams.

I'm a legal professional:

Yes!

After all the years you've spent working as a paralegal, legal secretary or another legal function that keeps the wheels turning, you too may now be able to qualify as a solicitor. All you need to do is check if you're eligible by registering and applying with the SRA.


I'm an overseas qualifed lawyer:

Yes!

If you want dual qualification, the SQE is the perfect next step. You may be exempt from one or both of the SQE exams – please register with the SQE to check and apply for exemption. You won't need QWE but you'll need to demonstrate your competence in the English or Welsh language (CEFR Level C2) – more information can be found on the BARBRI website and on the SRA website.







Timeline: How Long Will It Take to Qualify?

You can complete both of the SQE exams in one to two years.

SQE1 Exams:

- Prepare for 10 to 40 weeks (see our course start dates here)
- Sittings every January and July
- Results announced 2 months later
- You need to pass SQE1 to be able to book your SQE2 exam

SQE2 Exams:

- Prepare for 10 to 20 weeks
- Sittings every January, April, July and October
- Results announced up to 4 months later

Qualifying Work Experience:

• Complete a total of two years of QWE before, during or after your SQE studies

Applying to the SRA to Be Admitted:

 Background screening, character and suitability assessment and application generally take around 30 days (unless there's an issue with your screenings)


The SQE1 exam:

- A computer-based multiple-choice exam with 360 questions spread over 2 days.
- It tests functioning legal knowledge (FLK).
- The exam can be sat worldwide.



- Business Law and Practice (including taxation)
- Dispute Resolution
- Contract
- Tort
- The Legal System of England and Wales
- Constitutional and Administrative Law and EU Law
- Legal Services
- Property Practice (including taxation)
- Wills and the Administration of Estates (including taxation)
- Solicitors' Accounts
- Land Law
- Trusts
- Criminal Law and Practice

The SQE2 Exam

- A skills-based examination of 16 written and oral skills assessments.
- The written elements of the exam can be sat worldwide.
- The oral elements must be taken in person in England or Wales.

Skills Tested:

- Client interviewing (and attendance note)
- Advocacy
- Case and matter analysis
- Legal research and written advice
- Legal writing
- Legal drafting

Subjects Tested:

- Criminal Litigation (including advising clients at the police station)
- Dispute Resolution
- Property Practice
- Wills and Intestacy, Probate
 Administration and Practice
- Business Organisations, Rules and Procedures (including money laundering and financial services)

borbn Qualifying Work Experience


You need to complete at least two years of full-time Qualifying Work Experience (QWE) at up to four organisations. This can be taken before, during or after SQE1 and SQE2.

QWE is any paid or unpaid experience that gives you the opportunity to develop the competencies needed to practise as a solicitor. It could include:

- Undertaking a training contract
- Working in-house
- Working as a paralegal
- Placements during a law degree
- Working in a law clinic
- Working at a voluntary or charitable organisation, or a law centre

Your past or current work experience needs to be signed off by a solicitor to count towards the <u>SRA's requirements for QWE</u>.





What are the Eligibility Criteria?

Any degree or Level 6 equivalent qualification. No conversion course (eg PGDL) required.

How Much Do the SQE Exams Cost?

Exams are booked and paid for via the SRA portal.

• SQE1 exam fee: £1,888

• SQE2 exam fee: £2,902

Can I Apply for Reasonable Adjustments?
